### On condition of using the skatepark I will abide by the following.

- Helmets are compulsory and must be worn at all times when using the skatepark for activities.
- Redditch Wheels Project recommends knee, elbow and wrist guards to be worn along with the compulsory helmet to reduce bodily injury.
- Ask staff for a helmet if you do not have one, limb padding is also available.
- I am responsible for and will make sure my equipment is in good safe working order before using the skatepark.
- Behave in an orderly manner.
- Co-operate with skatepark staff and abide by their recommendations and instructions.
- Do not take into the skatepark alcohol or any illegal substances.
- Do not use and or trade illegal substances in or around the skatepark.
- Do use the skatepark under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances.
- Do not use the skatepark for any illegal activity.
- Do not use the skatepark while it is closed or unsupervised.
- Do not wax ramps.
- Do not use the skatepark or ramps if it is wet, icy or in an unsafe condition and I will report this to a supervisor.
- Do not commit any deliberate act that may put yourself and or anyone else at risk of injury or death.
- Only use the skatepark after paying the fee that is set by Redditch Wheels Project.
- Do not wilfully damage the skatepark, which includes Ramps, fence, surface and ancillary equipment.
- If in doubt or unsure, need help or advice ask the Skatepark Staff.
- If I am a beginner or novice I will seek advice from the staff and ride within my ability building up slowly.
- Be responsible for looking after my own belongings and will take care of them.
- Under 10's must be accompanied by an adult.
- Obey individual ramp and course rules

### Terms of use

- I accept skatepark activities and spectating are dangerous and can result in death and or bodily injury.
- I accept the risks involved and I am responsible for my own actions and or involvement at Redditch Skatepark and do so at my own risk.
- I have been given a safety briefing and briefed on the risks involved (see reverse).
- I am competent enough to use Redditch Skatepark.
- I have made the staff aware of any medical conditions such as diabetes or asthma and or others.
- Activities are not recommended for persons who have heart, back or neck conditions or who are pregnant, if you suffer from any illness or health problems you must consult your doctor before participating.
- I have made the staff aware of any existing bodily injuries.
- I give my permission for my photograph and film of me to appear on T.V, Internet, magazines, newspaper and any other publication.
- You may be asked to leave the facility for a time set by Redditch Wheels Project if the staff deem you are not meeting reasonable standards of behaviour, intoxicated by drink or drugs, taking part in criminal activity or for safety reasons and no monies will be refunded.
- Redditch Wheels Project may change its policies and fees from time to time.
- In signing this form you exclude to the fullest extent permitted by law all responsibility and liability to Redditch Wheels Project the facility operator, their board, employees, volunteers, officers or agents for death, bodily injury, illness, theft, damage or loss to personal property.

## Skatepark Safety Briefing

### As previous page conditions with added

- If you are new to riding the park ride around the ramps and courses to get used to them.
- If you are inexperienced ride a quieter or appropriate area to match and develop your skill level.
- Skatepark staff are here to help If you are inexperienced or unsure or have any problems ask advice from ramp park staff.
- If you have had an accident or have seen one happen report it to a supervisor immediately if you can for first aid and accident recording

### Vert, L shape mini spine and micro ramp.

- Be observant at all times, especially before dropping or rolling in on any ramp.
- Be aware of anybody dropping in or using the ramp.
- Do not sit on ramp coping, grind rails or sub boxes.
- Do not cross a ramp whilst it is being ridden or skated.
- Show courtesy at all times.
- All accidents must be reported to a member of staff.

### Large and small street course rules are the same as above but have these additions.

- Respect each others lines around the course.
- Check the bottom of the ramp is clear before you drop in.
- Look out for those who are dropping in while you are using the course.
- No congregating at the bottom of ramps.

### Spectators

- Do not cross ramps or street course or loiter on ramps or street course.
- Stay in designated areas keep off ramps and riding areas.
- Only those using Skateboards, bicycles, inline skates or other wheeled sports equipment are allowed on the ramps, street course and riding areas.
